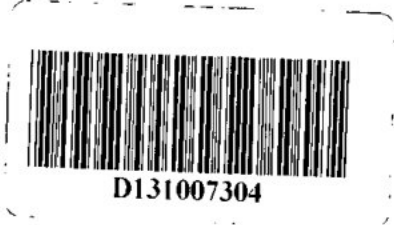

Now come the parties, by and through counsel, and in resolution of Father's
Motion to Modify Parenting Time, filed July 10, 2020, agree as follows:

1. **Parenting time:**

School year

Beginning the last full week prior to the first day of school, the parents shall follow
a two-week rotating parenting time schedule. Father shall have parenting time during
Week 1, beginning Sunday at 6:00pm until Tuesday school drop off (or to Mother's
home-in time for virtual learning if applicable), and during Week 2, Father shall have
parenting time from after he gets off work, which is approximately 8:30pm Friday until
Tuesday school drop off (or to Mother's home at 9:00am for virtual learning if
applicable).

Beginning the first full week after the last day of school, the parents shall follow a two-week rotating parenting time schedule in the summer. Father shall have parenting time during Week 1, every Sunday at 6:00pm until Wednesday at 5:00pm if Father is not working on that Wednesday, or Tuesday at 5:00pm if Father is working on Wednesday, and during Week 2, Father shall have parenting time after he gets off work, which is approximately 8:30pm Friday until Wednesday at 5:00pm if Father is not working that Wednesday, or Tuesday at 5:00pm if Father is working on Wednesday. Mother shall pick up [REDACTED] on Tuesday or Wednesday from Father. At the beginning of the summer, Father shall notify Mother of the Wednesdays he is working.

█████ should be transported in a booster seat until Mother determines otherwise, in accordance with the appropriate child safety guidelines. For transportation other than for regular parenting time described above, the parent beginning time (such as during holidays) shall provide transportation from the other parent's residence, unless agreed otherwise by the parents.

Each parent shall be responsible for transportation to and from █████ activities during his or her parenting time. Either parent may attend █████ activities regardless of which parent has parenting time during the time of her activities.

2. Holiday time: The parties shall exercise parenting time as agreed or as

* New Year's Holiday is governed by the year in which New Year's Day falls. It is not governed by the year in which New Year's Eve falls.

3. Extended Parenting time: The parties shall each be able to exercise two (2) weeks of extended parenting time with the minor child, to be taken in seven (7) day increments, not to exceed more than nine (9) consecutive days (with seven (7) days tacked onto two (2) days parenting time). The parties will make an effort to make sure

the parent not exercising the extended time can see the child before and after the vacation time. The parties shall give each other 30 days notice of exercising extended parenting time and in the event of a conflict, the parent who gave notice first shall be able to exercise that time. The parties shall provide the itinerary and information of accommodations for any travel during extended time.

4. The parents shall attend coparenting counseling. Mother has previously selected a coparenting counselor and both parents shall attend at least three (3) sessions of coparenting counseling, unless otherwise discharged by the coparenting counselor. The parents shall utilize any available insurance benefits, and after all eligible benefits are applied, shall equally divide the cost.

5. [REDACTED] shall continue in play therapy and both parents shall participate in play therapy and shall be in contact with [REDACTED] play therapist. The parties shall divide the cost of play therapy as a medical expense, as defined in their previous parenting agreement.

6. Neither parent shall use physical discipline when disciplining [REDACTED]. The parents shall strive for consistency in the form of discipline they employ.

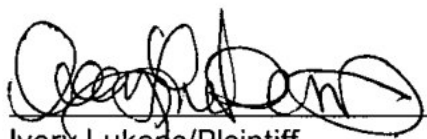
7. Each parent should encourage and not prevent [REDACTED] from contacting the other parent. Each parent shall ensure that [REDACTED] phone and/or watch is charged and available for [REDACTED] to use to contact either parent.

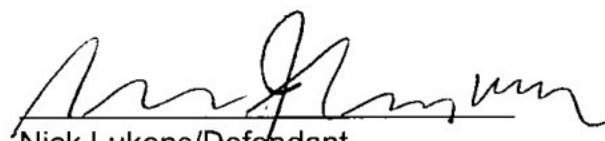
8. The parents shall use their best efforts to enhance and encourage the respect, love, and affection of [REDACTED] towards each parent. Neither parent shall make derogatory comments about the other or use profanity.

9. Neither parent should use illegal drugs around [REDACTED] nor should either parent drink in excess during his or her parenting time. If either parent suspects the other parent is in violation of this provision, he or she may file with the Court to request a drug screen and for an expedited hearing.

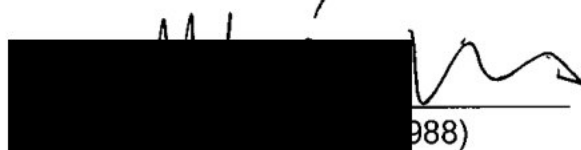
10. Mother remains the residential parent and legal custodian. Mother should consult with Father regarding major decisions, but ultimately makes the final decision. [REDACTED] should not be exposed to or allowed to use firearms or weapons until Mother explicitly approves of such in writing.

11. These parenting time provisions are meant to replace the provisions regarding parenting time, vacation time and holiday time in their current parenting agreement. All other orders not in directly conflict with this agreed entry shall remain in full force and effect.
